### 5. Twenty-Year Strategic Vision, Mission, and Goals

Mid-Western University is the state-funded institute of higher education in the Mid-Western region of Nepal. Established under the University Act in 2010 by the joint effort of government and local people MU is committed to imparting quality education, serving the nation and transforming rural communities by making equal access to community problem-solution based model of higher education with the following vision, mission, and goals for the 2016-2035.

#### Vision

The vision is to impart quality higher education in liberal arts, education, health science, law, science, management, agriculture, engineering, vocational and other technical disciplines for transforming socioeconomic systems by producing skilled, innovative human resources with a focus on character education for the betterment of mankind.

#### Mission

- The university will focus on a multi-disciplinary system of education, combining science, technology, and humanities to upgrade national higher education high up to International standard.
- The university will try to strengthen general education and open new disciplines related to general science, medical science, technical education, and vocational education.
- MU will establish new and acquired old educational institutions situated in various parts of the region, especially to provide technical education to the remote place and to the marginalized people.
- The university will give more emphasis on community-based research to bring improvement in the socioeconomic conditions of the region.

- To establish a well-furnished e-library of world class within the period of the 20-Year Strategic Plan.
- To reform curriculum through multi-interdisciplinary curriculum development and Community-based natural resources management approach.
- To enhance participatory and advisory approaches to teaching-learning and research.
- To promote an examination system based on semester-end and annual system.
- To offer academic programs with double streams.

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- To carry out research based on integrated methodology.
- To focus on a new method of students' training.
- To produce graduates equipped with comprehensive and problem-solving skills.
- To introduce a new program on the basis of an international and a national trend.
