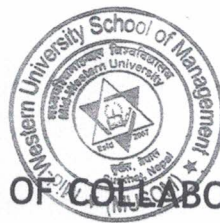

6. Exploring joint programmes.






